BRING FOOD AND A SWIMSUIT FOR POST-RIDE FUN.

ROUTE—ALMOST 13 MI.

GO NORTH (Mauka) on Ho‘owili Road a couple of hundred yards, then

LEFT on Po‘ipu Road.

LEFT (makai) at Sheraton sign on to Kapili Road - follow a couple of hundred yards then

RIGHT on Ho‘one Road

LEFT (west) on to Lawai Road - go past Beach House - then Spouting Horn - continue to end at gate at National Tropical Botanical Garden’s Allerton Garden gated entrance

RETURN - back on Lawai Road to the traffic circle near new Kukuiula Shopping Center

GO ABOUT 3/4 WAY AROUND the circle and EXIT on Ala Kalanikaumaka (the new Western Koloa bypass road). The shopping center entrance will be on your left.

FOLLOW to Koloa Road

TURN RIGHT (East) on Koloa Road

RIDE INTO Koloa Town

TURN LEFT on Maluhia Road, ride past Anne Knudsen Park

TURN RIGHT on Ala Kinoiki (stop sign) This is the old (Eastern) Koloa Bypass road

FOLLOW to stop sign at Poipu Road

CONTINUE straight ahead on to Pe‘e Road

CONTINUE on Pe‘e Road (Makai side of the Poipu Crater) and

GO RIGHT on Ho‘one Road at the ocean front. Brenecke’s Beach is a couple of hundred yards ahead.

FINISH ride at Po‘ipu Beach Park.
